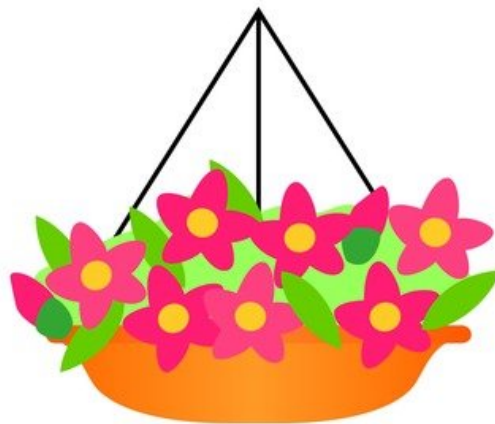
Buy-one-get-one-free Scholastic book fair is coming to our school the week of May 7<sup>th</sup>.

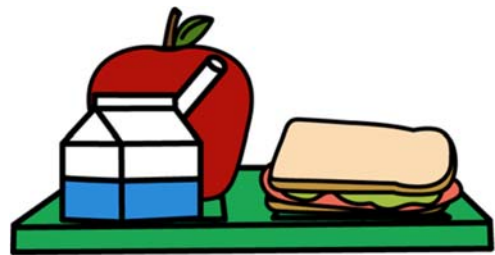

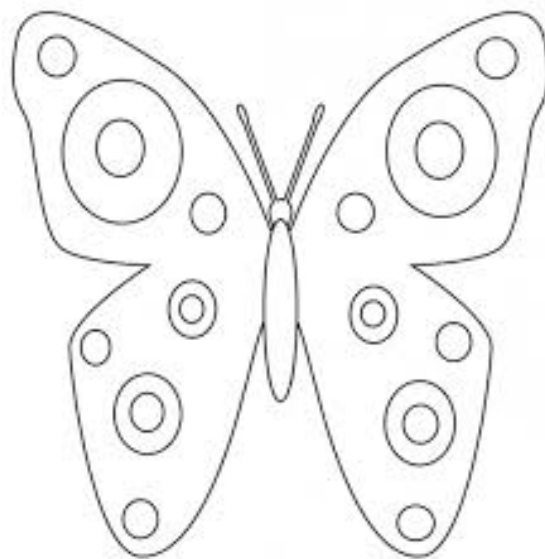
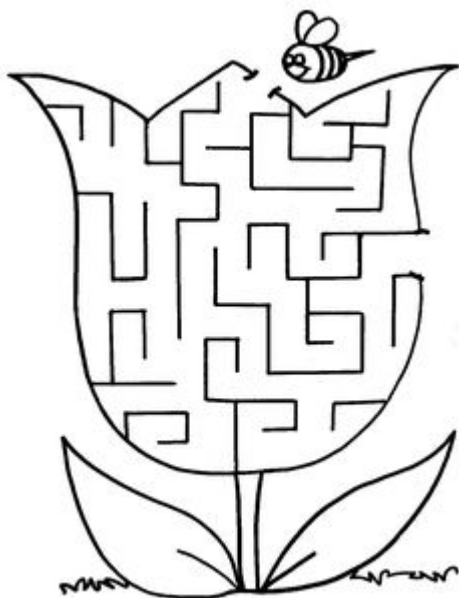
