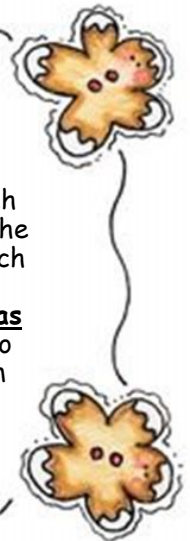
The PTL is in charge of decorating the church on Saturday, December 15. We encourage parents to come and help us out.

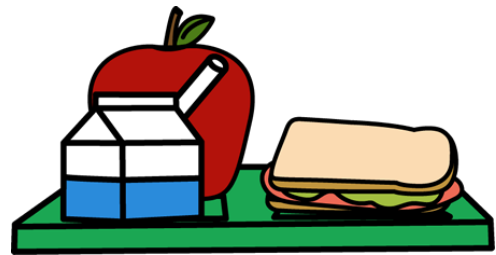
