This week we reviewed the arrival of the Wisemen, heard how Mary and Joseph found Jesus (the 12 year old) talking to the Church guys in the Temple, and how John (who was his cousin) had to Baptize Jesus so that Jesus could take all of our sins to the cross. We had two verses, Romans 10:17 Faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ, and 1 John 5:20 Jesus Christ, is the true God and eternal life. 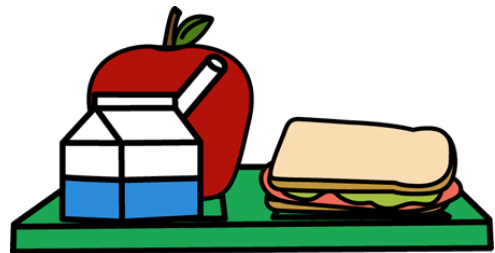
