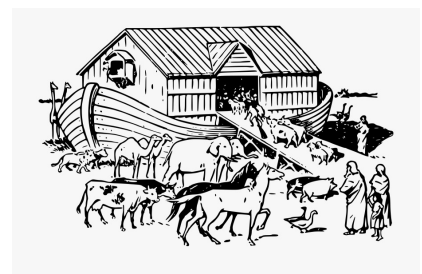
This week we heard about the great flood. Noah and his family and the animals were saved to repopulate the world.
